How to download eligibility certificate from mci website

The candidates can look up the name of MCI approved universities abroad on the official website of the MCI. If the University name is available there then that means the university is approved by the MCI and the graduates of the university can practice medicine in India after taking appropriate licensure exams. According to the Indian Medical Council Act, any Indian National/Overseas Citizen of India who wants to take admission into MBBS or its equivalent course in any MCI approved Medical University abroad, is required to obtain an Eligibility Certificate from the Medical Council of India, New Delhi before leaving the country to study MBBS abroad. The candidates are required to obtain a No Objection Certificate from the MCI and get all the necessary documents and mark sheets apostle by the Department of the Ministry of External Affairs to be officially eligible to appear for the MCI Screening Test/ Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (FMGE) after graduating from the foreign medical university. The council does not permit the holder of a primary medical qualification to appear for the Screening Test if they had not obtained an Eligibility Certificate from Medical Council of India. Candidate should register on the MCI website After registration log in with the given User ID and password to complete the application The application form will appear on the screen and Fill all the required details correctly After filling the form, upload the scan copies of all the required documents. Select the online or offline payment method to complete the application. In online mode, the fee is paid through the Payment gateway page. If offline mode, the scan copy of the demand draft must be uploaded and details of the DD should be provided and sent to the council along with other documents. Apply for Eligibility Certificate to the Medical Council of India, New Delhi on the prescribed application Form Send the Application form and original certificate/mark-sheet (along with Photostat copy) of the qualifying examination. After document verification, the original certificate shall be returned to the candidate and Photostat copy shall be retained by the Council. A Demand Draft made in favour of Secretary, Medical Council of India, New Delhi for the sum specified by the council should be submitted with the Application form. Copy of Documents at MCI can be submitted personally or through speed post within six months from the date of submission of online application. If any information furnished by the candidate is found to be incorrect or false during the investigation or at any subsequent stage, the Council may refuse to issue the eligibility certificate or if already issued may cancel the same. If the candidate is found to fulfil the eligibility criteria, the Council shall issue an Eligibility Certificate in the prescribed format to the candidate certifying that he/she is eligible to join the medical institution outside India to obtain a primary medical qualification. Candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Class shall produce a caste certificate issued by Competent Authority. The candidate shall also produce a birth certificate if it is not recorded in the certificate of the qualifying examination. Applicants who apply for Eligibility Certificate by sending their documents through post should enclose their original certificates for consideration of their application for issue of eligibility certificate. Those applications which are without original certificates will not be entertained by the Council office. Copies of documents required for applying the eligibility certificate with Application form in original are: 1.Proof of Nationality – passport along with the copy of all visa pages. 2.10th certificate along with the copy of transfer certificate and migration certificate. 3.11th&12th certificate (candidate should hold SSLC and 12th certificate from the board of examination but 11th certificate can be from the school where he/she have pursued the 11th education) with the copy of transfer certificate and migration certificate. 4.School leaving certificate for Bihar and Tamilnadu board students. 5.Community certificate issued by Tahsildar and it's English translation if issued in Regional Language. 6.Passport size photographs as per the instruction. 7.Admission letter issued by Foreign Medical University. 8.Year wise mark list of MBBS if already taken admission. If completed course then the copy of degree along with complete mark sheet of MBBS is required. 9.Copy of student ID card issued by the medical university if admission already has taken. 10.Affidavit on Rs. 10/-stamp paper has to be duly notarized. All documents should be self-attested by the candidate except the affidavit, the first page of application and admission letter which is to be attested by a Gazetted officer. Candidates are required to enclose the documents with the original form as per the order on the checklist and should be arranged and numbered based on the checklist. Applications without originals and incomplete documents will not be accepted by MCI. After the submission of application form to the council, alteration will not be allowed. The system will generate an acknowledgment form for the successful application. The basic FAQ is the time required to issue the eligibility certificate. MCI Eligibility Certificate is now mandatory for study MBBS in BangladeshFor getting admission to Graduate Medical Course in a Foreign Medical Institution us 12 and 13(4B) of Indian Medical Council Act, 1956This is to inform to all concerned that the requirement of obtaining Eligibility Certificate to pursue Primary Medical Qualification (MBBS or its equivalent) by an Indian, Citizen/Overseas Citizen of India is mandatory in terms of section 13(4B) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. It is also brought to attention that the requirement of obtainingEligibility Certificate was dispensed with by the Indian Medical Council (Amendment) First and Second Ordinance, 2013. However, with the lapse of the Indian Medical Council (Amendment) Second Ordinance, 2013, the requirement of obtaining Eligibility Certificate from the Medical Council of India stands revived w.e.f. 04.01.2014. The Executive Committee of the Council has decided to restart issuance of Eligibility Certificate w.e.f the current Academic Year i.e 2016-2017.Accordingly, public at large is hereby informed that in terms of Section 13(4B) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and Clause 4(2) of the Screening Test Regulation, 2002, an Indian National/Overseas Citizen of India who desires to take admission into MBBS or its equivalent course in a Medical University/Institution outside the country, is required to obtain Eligibility Certificate from the Medical Council of India, New Delhi before leaving the country. It is not permissible for holder of a primary medical qualification to appear in the Screening Test without obtaining an Eligibility Certificate from Medical Council of India.Therefore, all the applicants who have taken and/or desire to take admission into MBBS or its equivalent course in a Medical University/Institution outside the country may apply for Eligibility Certificate to the Medical Council of India, New Delhi on the prescribed application Form No. 1 along with all relevant documents and fee. It is also established to recognize the medical qualification in India and Abroad. It provides the permanent registration and provisional registration of doctors in India with the recognized medical qualification certificates. MCI creates a mutual recognition of medical qualifications in India and Abroad. Hence, there are many Government medical universities abroad recognized by MCI. Most of the medical aspirants tend to move abroad for higher education due to a lack of affordable medical seats in India. It is always advised that the students should confirm the status of any university before taking admission abroad. Students must check the university's status through the MCI website. If the university name is available on the MCI website, this indicates that the university is approved by the MCI. The Indian students who are seeking admission for MBBS from abroad or any relevant courses, they are required to obtain the No Objection Certificate from MCI. All the required certificates and mark sheets must be apostilled by the Department of the Ministry of External Affairs. Students to be able to appear for the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (FMGE) after their graduation, must obtain the Eligibility Certificate from the MCI before taking admission for MBBS from Abroad. For the application of the MCI Eligibility Certificate, the candidates should pass the required qualifying examination (10+2 Science Standard) either from India or the Indian citizen who qualifies an equivalent examination from abroad and is desired to pursue an undergraduate medical course in any foreign medical institution. Candidates must have the minimum 50% marks for general and 40% marks for those belonging to the reserved category in 12th Science standard (in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and English). In order to get the Eligibility Certificate from MCI, Students should follow the prescribed format provided by the MCI and must be accompanied by the original certificates of the qualifying examinations. Once registered, to complete the application, the applicant must log in with the given User ID and password. After logging in, click on the Eligibility Certificate which is available on the left-hand side of the dashboard. Click on Raise a request, the application form will appear. Fill all the required details (make sure to save the data from time to time as the form is lengthy). Once the form is filled, upload the scan copies of all the required documents. Make the online or offline payment to complete the application. If offline mode is selected, Demand Draft details should be provided. The applicant must upload the scan copy of the demand draft. If online mode, the applicant will be directed to the Payment gateway page directly.
